LEATHER

Cleaning

Stains can be removed using a soft cloth moistened with mild soap and water. Carefully avoid rubbing, instead gently dab from the edges to the centre of the stain. Dry immediately after treatment. Strictly forbidden the use of any aggressive cleansers or sprays, which may damage the natural leather's surface and texture over time.

Maintenance

Regularly dust the leather with a soft, dry cloth at least once a month. Avoid exposure to direct sunlight and heat sources. Never use steam..



COATED FABRICS

Cleaning

Any stains, spills or dirt must be cleaned immediately to avoid the possibility of permanent stains. Use a soft cloth moistened with mild soap and water for cleaning. Don't use any sprays or cleaning solutions containing alcohol, ketones, xylene, acetates and solvents, which cause direct damage and lead eventually the material deterioration.

Please do not use abrasive sponges which can cause serious damage to the surface.

Wipe dry with a clean, lint-free cloth.

Maintenance

The coated fabric must be cleaned regularly to maintain its appearance and prevent the build-up in dirt. We recommend vacuuming the surface at least once a month, using a low power Hoover.

Clothing made from unfixed dyed fabrics, or fabrics treated with bad dyes, can leave stains and halos in the lighter colours and it is not possible to guarantee the cleaning of these.



FABRICS

Cleaning

Always remove the stain as quickly as possible before it gets into the fibres. Most stains can be removed using a mild soap and water solution. Never rub hard to remove a stain and always use a clean white cotton cloth with small quantity of detergent solution. First soak up as much of the fluid as possible with simple white kitchen paper or a clean cloth.

If the stain is dried, remove it as much as possible with a vacuum cleaner.

Do not use sprays or cleaning solutions containing alcohol, ketones, xylene, acetates and solvents.

Maintenance

To preserve the colour and appearance of the fabric, we recommend vacuuming regularly with a soft brush, preferably every week.



ALUMINIUM AND METALS

Cleaning

Use a soft cloth and neutral domestic cleaner to remove minor stains. Then dry the area with a dry cloth, gently and evenly rubbing. In the case of persistent stains, it is possible to use solvent-free cleaning products, previously testing them in a hidden part to see their effect on the surface. Do not use acid or alkaline-based cleaning products. Do not use abrasive sponges, dishwashing detergents or similar.

Maintenance

Wipe the surface regularly with a soft cloth to remove the dust.

Sharp or pointed objects, such as blades or knives, can cause permanent damage to the surface, just like any hot or wet object.



WOOD**Cleaning**

Regularly clean the surface with a soft, lint-free cloth slightly moistened with neutral detergent instead of water, gently rubbing the surface to avoid moisture stains. Immediately remove any fluids from all wooden surfaces with a soft absorbent cloth.

Do not use acid or alkaline based products. Do not use microfibre cloths, abrasive sponges, dishwashing detergents or similar.

Maintenance

Generally, it is not necessary to use products for surface maintenance.

Sharp or pointed objects, such as blades or knives, can cause permanent damage to the surface, just like any hot or wet object.
